

Why Build?

We've explored our options and determined that constructing an innovation facility on our own acreage will best allow us to activate innovation. While our current test site has exceeded expectations, the reality is that we have outgrown the acreage we have and seek to provide additional capabilities to our partners.

Current challenges include:

- Grand Farm does not own its current acreage.
- Desire for closer proximity to growers and partners.
- Need for year-round access of permanent physical structure(s) and amenities.
- Lack of onsite capabilities including laboratory and prototyping.
- Inability to house full-time onsite staff.

Our Vision for the Innovation Facility

Over the course of deploying more than 350 agriculture technology projects in the field, we have gained valuable insight into the needs and capabilities required for our partners.

Our vision includes space to accommodate additional partners, staff, and community members. Including:

- Large welcome area that also tells the story of our region's leadership in agriculture innovation.
- Conference rooms and meeting space that provide classroom and presentation capabilities.
- Working office space for partners and staff members with individual desk space and group tables where product development can occur.

We envision capabilities to enable partners to ideate, create, build, and test all in one location. Including:

- Workshop space for product development and testing, the latest equipment, and private, secured workspaces with close proximity to project acreage.
- Large garage workshop space for development and testing on larger pieces of equipment with direct access to the field.
- Dirt track availability to conduct experiments in the field.

Our Story

Grand Farm empowers a neutral platform for industry, producers, higher education, and government to collaborate on autonomous and advanced agriculture technology.

Grand Farm started around a community challenge and has transformed into a global leader of AgTech innovation.

In 2017, local entrepreneur Barry Batcheller challenged the community to define our region's major - a specialty that attracts innovation and new businesses to the area. What followed was an idea to lean into our region's strong history in agriculture innovation and create a place where stakeholders across the globe could come together to solve the biggest challenges facing agriculture.

By 2018, local business and civic leaders had come together to champion the idea, led by Emerging Prairie. Local AgTech business owners, Kevin and Stacey Biffert, donated land to be used for the concept. By the spring of 2019, Grand Farm was positioned with land, partners, and projects. The U.S. Secretary of Agriculture, Sonny Perdue, came to North Dakota as a guest of Senator John Hoeven to help break ground on the Grand Farm Test Site. And in the fall of that year, Microsoft pledged \$1.5 Million to support and accelerate Grand Farm.

In early 2022, Grand Farm was awarded a \$10 Million matching grant by the North Dakota Legislature and State Department of Commerce to further advance agriculture technology through a world-class innovation facility.

Today, our partners are collaborating on cutting edge autonomous and advanced agriculture technology innovations, and Grand Farm has grown its reach from regional to global.
