As part of our Innovation-as-a-Service initiatives, you will lead three key programs: Solution Sourcing, Project Management, and Technology Scouting. Through Solution Sourcing, you will facilitate the process of identifying and implementing commercial or custom solutions for our partner organizations, providing them with the sprint capacity needed to propel their infrastructure and technology forward. Our Project Management program leverages Grand Farm Acres and Affiliate Acres to execute agrifood chain projects, while Technology Scouting empowers partners to gain comprehensive insights into specific technologies and their potential applications.

- Communication and leadership of the Program Management Office team to distribute capability and capacity across active projects to maintain proper timeline and budget
- Working positively across our multi-functional team to bring in the right capabilities and capacity while respecting the priorities of the team
- Problem solving when challenges arise within projects to make sure projects are completed successfully
- Interfacing with stakeholders to positively represent Grand Farm and bring more people and organizations into the Grand Farm ecosystem
- Speaking with executive team, boards members, at events and conferences, and with government officials on the status of current projects and reporting on completed projects
- Staying up to date on current cutting edge technologies and agriculture practices to have productive conversations with Grand Farm's ecosystem
